EUNIC Call for Participation - DIPLOMA SELECTION 2019



International competition of European diploma works in the field of product design and fashion announced by EUNIC Cluster Czech Republic (European Union National Institutes for Culture) and Designblok, Prague International Design Festival.

Designblok, Prague International Design Festival – is the most important event in the field of design, fashion, and jewellery in the Czech Republic since 1999. During its existence, over the past 20 years, the organizers have successfully collaborated with national institutes for culture and embassies on presentations of designers from the respective countries. Attended by both experts and the public alike, the event attracted over 50,000 visitors in 2018. Every year, Designblok guests include leading figures from public life, as well as famous designers from all over the world. Designblok has been listed among Prague's top seven city-wide events of the year.

Every year, Designblok supports young designers. As an EUNIC initiative, a special project has been set up for the selection of the best Czech and foreign graduates in the field of fashion and product design from prestigious European academies and universities.

This project is called **Diploma Selection**.

The two winners, one in product design and the other in fashion, will receive an award of 1.000 EUR. The best three in each category will be invited to Designblok 2020 as an international guests and have opportunity to present their new work/collection for free.

Project Description

- **Presentation** of the best contemporary Czech and international graduation projects in the field of product design and fashion on a professional level within Designblok official programme.
- **Unique venues**. Designblok takes place at the Industrial Palace of the Prague Exhibition Grounds and nearby locations such as National Museum Lapidary.
- Main exhibition venues are **Superstudio** (manufacturers, major brands, distributors, lifestyle etc.) and **Openstudio** (young individual designers, foreign guests, studios, schools etc.).
- **Product design graduates** will be presented in a group exhibition and the **Fashion** graduates will present their collections at a fashion show. Form, timing of fashion shows and other details shall be announced duly.
- **Accompanying programme** consists of presentations, lectures, openings, special installations, fashion shows, design, art and fashion talks, workshops, guided tours, etc.
- **Cooperation with EUNIC** joint efforts, networks and financial means can be more efficient in providing opportunity for young talents and creating a platform for individual country presentations.
- **Added value** Designblok is highly known, respected event, with a strong social potential, attracting thousands of visitors each year and having a matching role among designers, programmers, production companies etc.

Project Involvement Criteria

- Each participating EUNIC country will provide the list of schools and academies to be approached with a Call for Participation in the Diploma Selection. Each country agrees with Designblok on the procedure of contacting the respective school (directly or via Designblok).
- Ideas for members of international jury are welcome.
- Agreed and confirmed financial contribution of the individual participating country. The costs to be covered by the co-organizing cultural institute or an embassy are:
 - transport of the selected collection(s) and insurance (if necessary)
 - travel costs of the selected designer(s) and/or jury member(s)
 - accommodation while Designblok for the selected graduates and jury member(s)

Eligible Costs to be covered by Designblok

- Product design: venues presentation space within Openstudio, installation production
- Fashion: venue for a fashion show, backstage support, models, styling etc.
- Production and organization of the presentations
- Promotion / text editing, website design & editing, promo materials (programme, newspapers, catalogue) visual style, logo, promo-campaign in agreement with EUNIC members
- Guest service
