	All EU or EFTA citizens are allowed to stay within the territory of Poland for up to 90 days. After that period, they are obliged to register at the Immigration Office of Wielkopolska Voivodeship Office
VISA	in Poznań.

All applicants who do not come from EU or EFTA countries should obtain a student visa before entering Poland. Please contact the Polish Embassy / Consulate nearest to you for more information.
UAP will issue all documents required for applying for the proper student visa.
