

Information on Studying in English – Required Documents

To study in English in Poland, candidates must provide a document confirming their English language proficiency at a minimum level of B2. Accepted documents include certificates issued by the following institutions (at B2, C1, or C2 level):

- University of Cambridge, ESOL Examinations:
 - B2 First (FCE)
 - C1 Advanced (CAE)
 - C2 Proficiency (CPE)
 - B2 Business Vantage (BEC Vantage)
 - C1 Business Higher
 - Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (CEIBT)
- IELTS (University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations, British Council, IDP IELTS Australia):
 - Minimum score: 5.5
- Trinity College London:
 - ESOL Skills for Life – Level 1 (B2) or higher
 - Integrated Skills in English (ISE II or higher)
 - ISE Digital – above 80 points (B2)
- ETS:
 - TOEFL iBT – minimum 72 points
 - TOEIC – minimum: 785 (Listening & Reading), 150 (Speaking), 160 (Writing)
- Pearson:
 - Pearson English International Certificate – Level 3 or higher
 - PTE Academic (stationary or online) – minimum 59 points
- LanguageCert:
 - ESOL Communicator B2 or higher (Listening, Reading, Writing + Speaking)
 - LanguageCert Academic B2 or higher
 - LanguageCert Test of English B2 or higher
- LCCI:
 - English for Business Level 2 or higher
 - Foundation Certificate for Teachers of Business English (FTBE)
- ECL (European Consortium for the Certificate of Attainment in Modern Languages):
 - Level B2 (Vantage) or higher

- telc:
 - Certificate in English (various profiles including Business, Technical, University)

Additionally accepted:

- Certificate of completion of a preparatory language course lasting at least 9 months (B2, C1, or C2 level)
- Diploma of philology or applied linguistics (English), with at least 500 hours of language instruction
- Diploma specifying English as the language of instruction
- International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) – for the primary language
- European Baccalaureate Diploma (EB) – for L1 or L2
- Certificate of a sworn translator in English
