Regulation No. 68/2025/2026

of the Rector of the Magdalena Abakanowicz University of the Arts Poznan
of 18 March 2026

on tuition fees for foreign students from the academic year 2026/2027

Based on Article 79(1)(3) and (5) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, consolidated text), the following is hereby ordered for the academic year 2026/2027:

§ 1

1. This regulation defines the conditions of payment, including the amount of fees for foreigners undertaking studies, training, and participating in scientific research and development work at the Magdalena Abakanowicz University of the Arts Poznan (hereinafter referred to as the University), on a fee-paying basis.
2. This regulation applies to students of the University who are foreigners – not being citizens of the Member States of the European Union, the Swiss Confederation, or the Member States of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) – parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, and members of their families, and who do not hold a Polish Charter, studying on a fee-paying basis.
3. Foreigners pay tuition fees for studies conducted in the Polish language at first-, second-cycle, and long-cycle Master's programmes in the following amounts:
 - first-cycle studies – EUR 1,085 per semester (EUR 2,170 per academic year),
 - second-cycle studies – EUR 1,585 per semester (EUR 3,170 per academic year),
 - long-cycle Master's studies – EUR 1,335 (EUR 2,670 per academic year).
4. Foreigners pay tuition fees for studies conducted in English at first- and second-cycle programmes (except for students of Landscape Design) in the following amounts:



- first-cycle studies – EUR 2,900 per semester (EUR 5,800 per academic year),
 - second-cycle studies – EUR 3,400 per semester (EUR 6,800 per academic year).
5. Foreigners undertaking studies within an individual residency programme pay:
- for studies in English – EUR 2,085 per semester (EUR 4,170 per academic year),
 - for studies in Polish – EUR 1,085 per semester (EUR 2,170 per academic year).
6. In the case of repeating a semester or year in first- and second-cycle studies and long-cycle Master's studies due to unsatisfactory academic results, subject to point 7 and excluding students of Landscape Design, foreigners pay:
- first-cycle studies – EUR 750 per semester (EUR 1,500 per academic year),
 - second-cycle studies – EUR 1,100 per semester (EUR 2,200 per academic year),
 - long-cycle Master's studies – EUR 950 per semester (EUR 1,900 per academic year).
7. In the case of repeating the diploma semester in first- and second-cycle studies and long-cycle Master's studies due to unsatisfactory academic results, foreigners, except for students of Landscape Design, pay:
- first-cycle studies – EUR 500 per semester,
 - second-cycle studies – EUR 700 per semester,
 - long-cycle Master's studies – EUR 600 per semester.
8. The fee for conditional registration for the next semester or year of studies in first-, second-cycle, and long-cycle Master's studies is calculated by multiplying the number of ECTS points of the conditionally credited course(s) by the value of one ECTS point. The value of one ECTS point is EUR 45. The fee is payable by 1 February and/or 15 October of the academic year concerned. Decisions regarding conditional course repetition are made each time upon request of the interested party by the Dean of the Faculty. Failure to pay the fee within the above deadline constitutes grounds for removal from the student list.
9. The fees referred to in this regulation are paid in EURO and should be transferred to the following bank account:

10. The fees referred to in points 3–8 are payable by 15 October for the winter semester and by 1 February for the summer semester of the academic year concerned.
11. In justified cases, the Rector may extend the payment deadline or allow payment in instalments.
12. Statutory interest is charged on late payments. In the case of arrears exceeding three months, the student shall be removed from the student register.
13. Tuition fees are non-refundable, subject to point 14.
14. Tuition fees are refundable for periods of non-attendance if the foreign student has been granted a leave of absence or has resigned from studies for health reasons confirmed by a medical certificate, or for other important documented unforeseen circumstances.
15. In the case of difficult financial circumstances of the foreign student or undertaking a second field of study or another form of education on a fee-paying basis, the Rector may, upon request, reduce the fee or exempt the student from it entirely.
16. Foreign students studying under previously applicable regulations shall pay fees in the amounts specified in those regulations until the end of the study period provided for the given programme.

§ 2

This regulation enters into force on the date of signing.
